

# Civil War Research & Website Creation



## ASSIGNMENT

Working as a group, you will help to create this week's "Flipped Friday" by conducting Civil War related research and turning it into a website.

For web design, I suggest using either Weebly or Wix (both user-friendly and free), but you may, of course use whichever platform your group prefers. Each group will be given a group of people whose prominence and involvements will be the focus of your research. I've listed a bunch of resources on [www.msbard.com](http://www.msbard.com). You will write 10-15 questions that can be answered by viewing your group's selected sources and then create a website that offers your classmates each of the following:

### Something to **READ**

- a powerpoint presentation
- a prezi
- an article
- a webpage (check for credibility)
- a pictograph

### Something to **WATCH**

**A video, or combination of videos, of approximately 5 minutes.**

### Somewhere to **GO**

**Plan a virtual field trip by sending your classmates to landmarks, museums, and other locations that will help them understand your "people" and their interaction during the war.**

- complete an online activity
